

PROCTORS NEEDED FOR NEW YORK BAR EXAM! (Albany and Saratoga Counties only)

JULY 24th & 25th, 2018

Description of Duties: Proctors assist with the administration of the New York bar examination by checking-in exam applicants, distributing exam materials, monitoring applicants during the exam and maintaining the integrity and security of the examination process. Proctors are hired and compensated as State employees.

Requirements: Proctors must be at least 18 years old with a high school diploma or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Proctors must be able to stand and walk for lengthy periods and carry up to forty pounds. Proctors must be proficient in English and be reliable, responsible, courteous, and able to follow detailed instructions. Experience as a teacher, teacher's aide, teaching assistant or proctor is preferred but not required. The anticipated hours are 7:00 AM to 5:15 PM and the standard hourly rate of pay is \$15 per hour. Proctors must be able to work both days and attend a mandatory training session (proctors are compensated \$30 to attend training).
